Start at the bandstand and face away from the sea. Walk up the path with the Brook on your left.

1. What do we know as the Cygnus atratus?

Carry on and go over the bridge on your left

2. How long will it take you to walk to the Manor House?

Carry on up the path with the Brook on your right.

Cross the road and continue towards the Manor.

3. What is the speed limit when going up the steep hill to the doctor's surgery?

Carry on straight ahead

4. Dawlish community hospital is part of which NHS foundation trust?

Carry on straight ahead. Keep walking with the Brook on your right.

5. When was Victoria Mary Sells born?

Continue up the Brook and cross the bridge on your right. Bear right and walk through Manor House Gardens with the Brook on your right hand side.

6. Approximately, when was the Manor House built?

Continue forwards & follow the path. Walk past the blue building & continue onto Brook Street.

7. What woodland animal can be seen at number 54?

Keep going

8. What Dawlish number would you need to ring if you wanted to stay at Holiday cottage?

Continue straight ahead then turn left and go past the laundrette. Keep going and cross the road onto the stand.

9. How many stars can you count on the streetlamps?



Whilst on the Strand answer this question.

10. Between what times do you need to pay to park?

Head towards the crazy golf

11. How many giraffes can you count?

Continue towards the beach

12. What is the name of the huge piece of machinery helping to construct the sea wall?

Continue along the sea wall.....Did you enjoy that?

13. What gives the red cliffs and rocks their deep red colour?

Now head over the bridge and go down Marine Parade. Cross the road and head up towards the lawn but staying on the Brunswick side.

14. How many golden lamps can be seen above Gay's creamery?

Continue up the road
