



## Pram Race Entry Form 2021

Pram race in 2021 is limited to 40 prams maximum and due to the Covid-19 pandemic we have some extra measures to allow it to take place.

All pram race entrants will need to complete a form per person. Please make sure your team name is on all the forms so we can match them up if handed in separately. **All entries must be received by 12 noon on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> August to our information stall.** Late entries on the night cannot be accepted.

All pram race entrants will need to show evidence of a negative lateral flow test when arriving for the race and they will be called forward by our check in marshals as a team to do so. **Please arrive between 5pm and 6pm with judging 6pm to 6.45pm and the race starting at 6.45pm.**

The lateral flow tests should be done on the day or the day before the pram race – we cannot do them on site for you. To report a result go to: <https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result> On the evening please show the text message sent from the NHS on your phone to the check in marshals.

**Please do not come to the pram race if you have any symptoms of Covid-19 or have tested positive or have been told to self-isolate.**

### **Rules of entry:**

1. No fridges or freezers are to be used and all prams and other wheeled constructions used in the race have to be taken away and disposed of by your team if the pram can be moved.

There will be an area where prams which have fallen apart can be left, but please take away your pram if you can. Devon Contract Waste will dispose of any left behind.

2. No throwing of any substances into the crowd either on the Lawn or anywhere on the route.

Please do not use water pistols.

3. Teams have to consist of 3 people over the age of 18 years old.

4. All members of the team have to sign individual entry and disclaimer forms.

5. Any contestant who cannot provide evidence of a negative lateral flow will not be allowed to take part in the event.

6. One member of the team should attach £10 entry fee for their team with their form when returning the forms to the Information Tent.

7. The judging may take some time if there are lots of entries so, please be patient.

### **DISCLAIMER:**

1. Dawlish Celebrates Carnival will not be held responsible for any injuries or death that may occur during this event.

2. Any contestant who is found to be intoxicated by alcohol or drugs or is abusive will not be allowed to take part in the event.

3. Dawlish Celebrates Carnival will not be held responsible for any damage to any parked vehicles or buildings along the route.
4. Dawlish Celebrates Carnival will not be held responsible for any throwing of substances into the crowds along the route, nor for any substance that is thrown at buildings during the event.

6. Entrants are subject to the Dawlish Celebrates Carnival Pram Race Marshals discretion.
